

House bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquor or lager beer in the village of New Market, (Maryland Line P. O.,) in the first precinct of the 7th election district, in Baltimore county, Md., or at any place within said Baltimore county, within a radius of one mile of the Methodist Protestant Church in said village of New Market."

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Betts, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Washington county to refund to Abraham Corbett of said county a certain sum of money for taxes erroneously paid to said County Commissioners by him."

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Applegarth, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 35 and 36 of Article 10, Public Local Laws, title 'Dorchester County,' sub-title 'Birds and Game,' to be known as 'Sections 1 and 2.'"

Which was read the second time.

Mr. Peter, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to give the consent of the State to the purchase of a lot or lots of ground in Elliott city, in Howard county, Maryland, by the United States of America, for the purpose of erecting thereon a public building, and to cede to the United States of America jurisdiction over the same."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Rohrback, from Select Committee, reported favorably, with proposed amendment,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Frederick county to issue bonds bearing interest at a rate not to exceed three and one half per centum per annum, to obtain money to redeem the sixty-five thousand dollars of bonds, bearing interest at four per centum per annum, issued by said county commissioners under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the session of 1884, chapter 494,
