

town for the purpose of constructing water works and electric lights for said town, to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said town to redeem said bonds and pay the interest thereon."

"An Act to repeal section 205, of Article 16, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Chancery,' as amended by the Act of 1892, chapter 241, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add an additional section to said Article, to be numbered '205 A.'"

"An Act to repeal section 32, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Revenue and Taxes,' sub-title 'Collectors and Collections,' so far as the same relates to Montgomery county, and to add a new section to be known as 'Section 226, to Article 16, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Montgomery County,' sub-title 'Taxes,'"

"An Act to repeal sections 18 and 19, of the charter of Takoma Park, Maryland, and to re-enact said sections 18 and 19."

"An Act to change the name of the Maryland Title, Insurance and Trust Company, and to authorize an increase in the number of its directors."

"An Act to repeal chapter 231 of the Laws of 1898, entitled "An Act to confer on the Chesapeake Beach Railway Company the powers, rights and franchises granted to the Washington and Chesapeake Beach Railway Company by chapter 245 of the Acts of 1894, entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Chesapeake Beach, in Calvert county, and to re-enact said chapter 245, of the Acts of 1894 with amendments.
