

posed they may provide for the imprisonment of the offender for a period not exceeding thirty days in the town lock-up or county jail, or until the fine and cost are paid. All ordinances and resolutions now in force and not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act shall remain in force until altered or repealed by competent authority. No provisions of this Act shall affect any right, lien or liability subsisting at the date of its passage.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from May first, in the year nineteen hundred.

CHAPTER 483.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Frederick County to issue bonds bearing interest at a rate not to exceed three and one-half per centum per annum to obtain money to redeem the sixty-five thousand dollars of bonds bearing interest at four per centum per annum issued by said County Commissioners under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the Session of eighteen hundred and eighty-four, Chapter four hundred and ninety-four, and also to redeem the one hundred and twenty-three thousand and seven hundred dollars of bonds bearing interest at four per centum per annum, issued by said County Commissioners under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the Session of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, Chapter two hundred and thirty-nine, both of which issue of bonds are now redeemable and may be paid by said County Commissioners, and to authorize and empower said County Commissioners to levy and collect the necessary taxes for the payment of the bonds hereby authorized to be issued and the interest thereon.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Frederick County be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds of Frederick County to an amount not to exceed in the aggregate one hundred and eighty-eight thousand and seven hundred dollars, in sums of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars each, to be signed by the
