

In cases of appeal, etc. 117H. That in all cases where fines, penalties or forfeitures shall be imposed by said police justice, and an appeal shall be taken, and the Circuit Court shall affirm the judgment of said police justice, the fine, penalty, forfeiture and costs taxed by said justice to the extent of same imposed by said police justice shall, when collected, be paid to the said County Commissioners, to become part of the aforesaid separate fund, and be appropriated as hereinbefore required.

Change of justice. 117I. That the justice of the peace so selected as police justice may be changed from time to time by the Governor at his discretion, and any other justice of the peace may be selected to perform the duties of the said police justice.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That all Acts, general or local, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed in so far as they may conflict with this Act.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
