CHAPTER 550.

AN ACT to repeal Section forty of Article II of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Birds and Game," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section forty of Article II of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Birds and Game," be and the same hereby is repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Sec. 40. That it shall not be lawful for any person to shoot, trap, or by any other means to kill, destroy or catch any pheasant or partridge within the limits of Frederick County before the fifteenth day of November, in the year nineteen hundred and two, and that after the said fifteenth day of November, in the year nineteen hundred and two, and each year thereafter, it shall not be lawful for any person to shoot, trap, or by any other means to kill, destroy or catch any pheasant or partridge within the limits of said county except between the fifteenth day of November and the twenty-fourth day of December, inclusive, in each and every year.

CHAPTER 551.

AN ACT to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the deed from the German-American Fire Insurance Company to Israel Baptist Church of Baltimore City.
