2 does not forbid the legislature from going into executive
3 session, no, but it simply states the policy of allowing
4 or stating the policy that people shall have the right
5 to know how the government operates. If it worries you,
6 take it out.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Storm. There is time
8 for just one more question, and answer, if the question
9 is brief.

10 DELEGATE STORM: Mr. Kiefer, I am trying to get
11 you two together. Would you look at amendment No. 24.

12 Would this be satisfactory with you if the last
13 clause were stricken out, and the whole section had the
14 following words added to the beginning: " -- to the
15 extent provided by law --" all government proceedings,
16 and so on.

17 Would this meet with your approval?

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Kiefer.

19 DELEGATE KIEFER: Yes, this in effect is what
20 I am trying to say.
