

1 Delegate Hosterred had the floor to make his motion
2 to reconsider the vote by which Amendment 5 was rejected.

3 During the dinner recess, it had been agreed
4 to that the matter would be made a special order. The Chair
5 had indicated at that time that there were, I think, three
6 other amendments to section 1.17 which the sponsors had
7 indicated they wished to offer in the event Amendment No. 5
8 was rejected, and the Chair had indicated that if it was
9 rejected, the sponsors of those amendments would be recog-
10 nized in the order indicated.

11 Since the action on Friday, a number of Dele-
12 gates have asked me to advise them as to the parliamentary
13 situation with respect to the consideration of this matter
14 and any amendments that may be desired to be offered.

15 I have expressed the opinion of the Chair as to the
16 parliamentary situation, and I think since this has been
17 made known to a number of delegates on both sides of this
18 issue that it would be well if I would state it now to the
19 entire Convention, so that all of you would be fully advised
20 as to what the Chair conceives the parliamentary situation
21 to be.
