

1 DELEGATE BOILEAU: No.

2 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Boileau votes No.

3 Does any delegate desire to change his vote?

4 The Clerk will record the vote.

5 There being 14 votes in the affirmative and
6 83 in the negative, the motion is lost and the amendment
7 rejected.

8 Delegate Penniman, earlier today the Chair
9 suggested to Dr. Phillips, the staff adviser of your com-
10 mittee, the possible necessity or desirability of
11 further amendment to section 10.02. Has he discussed it
12 with you or your committee?

13 DELEGATE PENNIMAN: No, he has not.

14 THE PRESIDENT: The Chair would like to put the
15 question then to Delegate Boyer and also to you, Delegate
16 Penniman. It is more a question of substance, but it
17 may be effected by a style change.

18 As section 10.02 is now written, it provides for
19 the amendment of the Constitution either by the proposal
20 by the General Assembly or it proposed by the members of
