

1 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Gleason.

2 DELEGATE GLEASON: This question borders
3 on the technical side of things, but it has always been
4 my impression that really the House is not in session
5 unless the Assembly is in session. I think there is a
6 great deal of merit in this proposal because certainly
7 if charges of impeachment or cries for impeachment have
8 been raised, it is in the interest of the person accused
9 to have this matter handled expeditiously, and therefore
10 I think the House should have the power to call themselves
11 into session, since we have given them this power of
12 bringing forth the bill of impeachment, but I am wondering
13 if you would change this first sentence to say if the General
14 Assembly is not in session, to keep it consistent with the
15 fact that the Assembly, after all, is the legislative
16 body as such, and that is the one that should be in
17 session.

18 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Gleason and
19 Delegate Sollins, the Chair calls your attention to the
20 fact that there is provision for the separate session
21 of the Senate only. It would be impossible for the Senate
