

1 It was certainly our intention in order to
2 be eligible to vote for a member of the House of
3 Delegates, or a Senator, or a Congressman, indeed you had
4 to be a registered voter in that district.

5 For this reason we are offering the language
6 in amendment 10. This is substantially the same language
7 as you will find in Article 1, section 1 of the present
8 Constitution.

9 I sincerely hope that you will act favorably on
10 this amendment.

11 THE PRESIDENT: Any questions of the sponsor
12 of the amendment?

14 DELEGATE BURDETTE: Mr. President, in line
15 10, Delegate Koss -- there is a problem of language which
16 seems to leave me with uncertainty as to the meaning. It
17 says then to entitle a person to vote for such an officer,
18 the person, I wonder if you mean by that "then to vote for
19 such an officer a person". The second one is very closely
20 related.

21 I am sure that Delegate Loss has no intention of
