3 legislative delegations from time to time have been not  
4 too amused to find that what looked like a great promise  
5 in one House had been virtually by pre-arrangement doomed to  
6 oblivion by the action of the other House, making it  
7 therefore quite difficult to know actually where the axe  
8 had fallen and who actually was responsible for the final  
9 result.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions of the Minority  
11 spokesman? Delegate Gleason?

12 DELEGATE GLEASON: Mr. President, Mr. Chairman,  
13 I would like to ask the spokesman for the Minority if he  
14 would provide the assembly with some kind of a figure as to  
15 what would be the size of this unicameral legislature.

16 DELEGATE HANSON: I have suggested that if the  
17 Convention adopts our proposal, that there be a unicameral  
18 legislature, that I would then propose an amendment to  
19 Section 3.04 to establish the size of that body at one  
20 hundred.

21 We indicate this on page 1 of the Minority report.
