

1                   DELEGATE GLEASON: I presume you are using  
2 that word "stumbled" rather loosely. I might say to the  
3 delegate that he had the same basic research material before  
4 him that I did. Essentially, there are two books. One  
5 put out by the State Council of Governments, and the  
6 other put out by Citizens' Conference on State Legislatures.  
7 Both are recent books, both up to date. I am saying to  
8 him, and what I have said to Delegate Chabot, he may not  
9 want to accept the answer, but it is the answer, that that  
10 information was not available in those books, and I was  
11 not able to procure it anywhere else. Maybe the Chairman,  
12 who has done a great deal of research, and of course, who  
13 has research assistants, may have come up with the answers.  
14 I would be very happy to have the answer myself.

15                   THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher?

16                   DELEGATE GALLAGHER: May I say, by way of ques-  
17 tion, that would it be proper to suggest to Delegate  
18 Gleason that your book of material contains the fact that  
19 Montana and Virginia set the size of the legislature  
20 by law, as contained on Page 24 of the research document  
21 to which you just referred to.
