

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Are there any other questions?
2 Delegate Taylor?

3 DELEGATE L. TAYLOR: In the case of Baker v.
4 Carr, in the State of Tennessee, I believe the one man-one
5 vote principle was ruled. Do you have any knowledge as to
6 how the State of Tennessee treats this problem, for the size
7 of the legislature?

8 DELEGATE GLEASON: No. The only knowledge that
9 I have that is relevant to the question, at least to my
10 mind, is that since those decisions, forty-five States have
11 apportioned themselves, and three more are in the process,
12 which is a pretty good degree of legislative activity on
13 that kind of a basis, in a period of five years; but I
14 don't know what this current situation is in the State of
15 Tennessee.

18 DELEGATE WILLONER: Delegate Gleason, I was
19 wondering if you had any statistics on any of the legis-
20 latures that have reapportioned themselves and have re-
21 duced their size?
