

1 THE CHAIRMAN: The time of debate having ex-  
2 pired, the question arises on the adoption of Amendment  
3 No. 4. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the adoption of  
4 the amendment. That is, to leave --

5 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: Mr. Chairman.

7 A vote No is a vote against the adopting of the  
8 amendment.

9 For what purpose does Delegate Wheatley arise?

17 that would specify exact numbers without provision under  
18 law?
