2 left it solely to the legislature as to whether or not  
3 it would fix its own numbers. There are two, is the  
4 answer. Forty-eight think that there ought to be a limit.

5 I believe there ought to be a limit, and our  
6 committee, and I believe the small counties, the  
7 small communities think that this legislature has to stay  
8 workable. You are not going to understand their concern.

9 I believe that in the compromise which is involved  
10 in this amendment there are the possibilities of a great  
11 many different answers to the problems which face us, and I  
12 believe that as we delegate so many other functions to the  
13 legislature it is proper for us to delegate to the  
14 legislature the possibilities of providing better  
15 government within limits. This is the view which the  
16 minority adopts, and we respectfully urge that you vote  
17 favorably upon the amendment to the committee recommendation.
