2 county or unit of government would be able to divide  
3 the state as it wished within its boundaries.

4 Would you explain this apparent difference?

5 DELEGATE RYBC ZNSKI: This is based on an assumption  
6 that the General Assembly, acting as a unit, will go along  
7 with each area as to how it wants to vote.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Chabot?

9 DELEGATE CHABOT: A further question:

10 Is it clear in your mind that the General  
11 Assembly can make the decisions district by district and  
12 is not compelled to choose either Method A or Method B for  
13 the entire state at any one time.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Rybczynski?

15 DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: I guess it could. The  
16 General Assembly could, but I do not believe that it  
17 will.

18 I cannot imagine that it would happen.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Chabot?

20 DELEGATE CHABOT: A further question: You had  
21 indicated that under the committee's proposal and Delegate
