

1 legislation and re-enact it. This would give them the
2 opportunity to say well, we are a little better informed
3 than you all are on the legislation and we will re-enact
4 it because we know more about it than you do. For that
5 reason we so do.

6 This three-fifths vote of each House allows
7 for pliability of the legislature. I think if we put
8 any bite at all to the referendum proposal, we should
9 include something of this sort.

10 DELEGATE JAMES: Delegate Koss.

11 DELEGATE KOSS: It seems to me the same
12 arguments made previously to the previous amendment
13 holds true. It still prevents the General Assembly from
14 re-acting to a majority of the people.

15 DELEGATE JAMES: Any other member wish to
16 speak on the subject? The Chair recognizes Delegate
17 Siewierski.

18 DELEGATE SIEWIERSKI: I would like to speak
19 on behalf of the amendment. I don't believe Delegate
20 Hutchinson mentioned during the past 26 years the legisla-
