

1 it, on the governor about 1964 or 1965 to perform his duties.  
2 My recollection also is that the chairman agreed that  
3 that was done.

4 It seems to me that as a layman this is an  
5 answer to the problem, and not the assumption of the authority  
6 and duties and responsibilities of the governor by the  
7 judiciary.

8 As a matter of fact, I think that the matter  
9 is not too great a problem, except it is invasion of the  
10 responsibilities of one branch of government by another.  
11 Therefore, I should like to support the suggestion, or the  
12 recommendation.
