

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Child seconds.

2 The Chair recognizes Delegate Chabot to speak
3 to the amendment.

4 DELEGATE CHABOT: This is intended to take
5 care of another possibility which I suppose is likely to
6 occur, at least as often as the possibility taken care
7 of in the committee's draft of 5.14.

8 In the nature of things, people pass away,
9 people move, people have second thoughts as to whether or
10 not to accept a possible appointment. Such activity,
11 which would cause the list of nominees to be reduced
12 below the number that we have required, that is, below
13 the number three, ought not to compel the governor to
14 appoint from a list which would have been an insufficient
15 list if it had been presented to him that way in the first
16 place.

17 For example, if there people had been presented
18 on the list, and one had passed away so that there were
19 only two left, if the nominating committee had originally
20 presented only two people, the list would not have been
21 a sufficient one and the governor could have rejected it.
