

1 DELEGATE JAMES: So that it conceivably could
2 be mandatory, and if the facilities for recording debates
3 and proceedings by minute stenographic transcript are not
4 available, then the General Assembly would be immobilized.

5 This is the question that this raises.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Gallagher.

7 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: You are asking me for the
8 effect. I wish I could give you a better answer. I simply
9 say that if things come to that stage of the game when
10 you can't get a stenographer, that you must be in a great
11 hu-ry.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate James.

13 DELEGATE JAMES: It could easily happen.

14 Now, the next thing along the same line is the
15 requirement that the committee votes be attached in the
16 same manner, in the record in the same manner as votes of
17 the entire house are now attached and made record.

18 Would this go so far as to include the votes of,
19 for instance, standing subcommittees of a major committee?
20 How far down the lines does this committee requirement go?
