3 fact, due to a clerical error on the part of some assistant,
4 some mistake occurs, we don't have to stop a billion dollar
5 program like they did in the Redland's case. This is the
6 point Senator James has raised. The Committee in good faith
7 went out and resolved the issue. It is mandatory. It means
8 substantial compliance. There isn't a reason in the world
9 that any judge sitting on the Circuit Court would be
10 confused about it at all. There are other sections in here,
11 not only mandatory but literal like recording the votes.
12 There isn't any question about those but the fact the
13 argument for the proponents of the amendment is simply this:
14 That they don't think that these matters should be in the
15 Constitution. They should be matters of rules but when they
16 get back to adopting the rules you won't find them in the
17 rules. I urge you to oppose this amendment.
