2 government.

3 Mr. Chairman, I strongly urge all members of
4 this Committee to disregard this question of the military.
5 For those of you who have not had the benefits I did
6 of two years in the U. S. Infantry, allow me to suggest
7 to you that the only thing that you do in the Army is
8 obey blindly orders. This is taught to you so when the
9 superior gives you a certain order on the battlefield,
10 you do it and you do it blindly. This is the only form
11 of training given to you in the military, not a question
12 of discretion, but a question of might.

13 As to the polls, anything can be done with
14 polls. It is just like statistics. You do anything you
15 want with them.

16 But let me point out to you that on our very
17 first day of consideration of this question in our Committee
18 two members of this delegation brought some school
19 children into our committee room.
