2 DELEGATE ULRICH: Mr. Chairman, I rise to  
3 oppose the amendment calling for the age of eighteen.  
4 I support the majority report of nineteen. I attended  
5 a hearing one night, public hearing, on suffrage and  
6 elections. There were several hundred young people there.

7 I am sure when it comes time for the document  
8 to be ratified, the people that were at this hearing that  
9 night will know well what it did in this document. There  
10 was only one person who opposed lowering the voting  
11 age.

12 We have been very pleased in this Convention  
13 in having fine young people to be with us, and I wondered  
14 if they would voice their opinion at this time, the  
15 pages, letting us know.

16 Everybody says the young people don't want the  
17 voting age lowered. I wondered if they would voice their  
18 opinion now and let us know how they feel, the pages  
19 here in the Convention?

20 THE CHAIRMAN: The Chair suggests they are not  
21 registered as lobbyists and would not be able to do that.
