

1 your amendment as another amendment to the Committee
2 recommendation. In other words, you have these choices
3 open. If you offer your amendment now as an amendment to
4 Amendment No. 1, it gives the Committee of the Whole the
5 opportunity to decide whether Amendment No. 1 shall have
6 in it the age twenty-one or twenty. If your motion
7 fails, the Amendment 1 would then be submitted, and the
8 Committee of the Whole would decide on the twenty-one
9 versus age nineteen. If your amendment succeeded, then
10 Amendment No. 1 would be submitted, and the Convention
11 would decide on age twenty versus age eighteen. If you
12 do not submit your amendment now, and Amendment No. 1 is
13 submitted to the Committee of the Whole and fails, the
14 Committee recommendation is still open to amendment
15 and you could then submit your amendment to vote on the
16 age twenty versus nineteen. If, however, you do not submit
17 your amendment now and Amendment No. 1 passes, the
18 Committee of the Whole has decided that the age is
19 twenty-one, and there would, therefore, not be any oppor-
20 tunity to consider it further.
