

1 THE CHAIRMAN: If Amendment No. 21 is adopted,
2 it would eliminate the last two paragraphs of Section 7,
3 which would, of course, include the second paragraph
4 as amended by Amendment No. 14.

5 Delegate Clagett.

6 DELEGATE CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, another
7 parliamentary inquiry. How can we get to a vote on
8 Section 7 eliminating Amendment No. 14?

9 THE CHAIRMAN: The effect of Amendment No. 14,
10 you mean apart from a consideration of Amendment 21?

11 DELEGATE CLAGETT: Well, as I understand,
12 Amendment 21 is before us now and we are going to have to
13 yea or nay on that.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: If it is adopted, it in effect
15 nullifies everything done in Amendment 14.

16 DELEGATE CLAGETT: Then my question is how can
17 we go back and vote on Section 7 as the committee originally
18 recommended it.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: To move to reconsider Amendment
20 14.
