2 THE CHAIRMAN: In order that the Chair may
3 paraphrase the question, I think he is asking you whether
4 it is the intention to require on the first section on
5 page 1 that to be eligible for attorney general a person
6 must have been a citizen for five years and must have
7 been a member of the Bar of the state for five years, or
8 whether he could have been a citizen for one month if
9 he had been a member of the Bar of the state for five
10 years.

11 DELEGATE MORGAN: I think that he must have
12 been a citizen and also a member of the Bar for five years
13 and this language, I am advised, really tracks the lan-
14 guage in the judicial article and as to the judicial
15 article, I will refer to Chairman Mudd, I think it
16 would require to be eligible to be a judge, you had to
17 have been a citizen for five years and also a member of
18 the Bar for five years.
