2 all court cases that they might be involved in until after
3 the Convention is over.

4 It seems to me we were elected to do a job and
5 those delegates who are interested in doing that job know
6 they owe this to their people back home.

7 THE PRESIDENT: Call for the question. A vote
8 Aye is a vote --

9 DELEGATE FORNOS: Mr. President, I would like
10 to call for a roll call.

11 THE PRESIDENT: A vote Aye is a vote in favor
12 of the motion, a vote in favor of the proposition that the
13 Convention will sit on Friday, October 27. A vote No
14 is a vote in opposition to the motion. It does not mean
15 that the Convention will not sit on the 27th, the
16 Convention will decide that at the proper time. Roll
17 call vote has been called for. Delegate Boyce.

18 DELEGATE BOYCE: As I understand a roll call,
19 the roll call is to defeat Mr. Fornos' motion. If that
20 be so, then doesn't the calendar hold that we decided
21 the other day?
