and or this so ever known or called with all and singular the assents and other the same to be  
and the same or any part thereof for me and in my name to view and survey and the same land or  
any part thereof for me and in my name, to bargain sell lease and grant to any person or persons with  
power and for sure estate, for life or lives, Inheritance, and for sure sum or sums of money, as to  
my said Attorney shall be thought most and convenient to the uttermost best to the use and profit of me  
the said William: Crail, and the good or goods of the said grant or grants so to be made or now and in my  
name to make seal and ad my deed deliver unto the party or parties to whom the same shall be made, or to  
any other, to hold or have unto the use of one or more parts of the same or means in my name to accept receive  
and also all such sums of money as shall grow due for the same for me in my name and to  
my use to gather receive and take, and all such rents duties and arrears of Rents & profits as are already  
hereafter shall become due or payable for out of or touching the premises or any of them to receive  
and also all other debts or sums of money, tobacco Indian Cens what so ever shall or may become  
due or payable to me in any part of this Province of Maryland or in the Colony of Virginia from any person  
persons whatsoever for me and in my name and to my use, to ask sue for carry receive and receive and  
upon the receipt of any of the said sums of money, to pay the Indian Cens or arrearages or other charges  
and debts in my name to make seal and deliver, and for the recovery of any such debt or debts out or more  
my Attorney to constitute & appoint, and the same at his will & pleasure to receive, and all other  
things and things, debts and duties in the law needfull and necessary for the recovery of any  
debt or debts as to the said Attorney shall seem most & convenient in the premises to attend, giving & doing  
granting unto my said Attorney my full power and authority touching & concerning the premises to do execute  
and finish in all things in any manner to all intents and purposes as if my self might or could do ratifying  
allowing and holding firm & stable what so ever my said Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in and  
out the premises or any of them according to the true intent and meaning of these presents. In witness
