O^r M^r. That the Commissioners of each respective County Court in
the Province of Maryland do forthwith inspect into and take an account
of all Bonds and Recognizances taken before them in Court or otherwise

violated, to cause prosecution thereof to be made according to Law in their sd Court

or Contumacious of such Bonds or Recognizances to take process of such persons
now Bonds with security for their future good behaviour & according to Law.
