have and to hold the said Cows and Calves with their foucal^s outwards to her the
said also Hill for ever the said Cattle to run with my owne until she attains to y^e
of sixteen years and then to enjoy the said Cattle as her owne proper goods for
ever or at day of her marriage and not to dispose of until the day of marriage or
until she is sixteen years of age, except both of our consent is given with her
owne consent the increase of male to belong properly to me William Joubert until
the day of marriage or sixteen years of age then the said also Hill to have
both male and female & future Increase of both male and female to her &
said also Hill, Executors and Assignes for ever without any let Hindrance
molestation or interruption of us the said William and also my wife Joubert
utterly forbidding our selves of having any right, Cattle or interest therein
excepted as before is excepted in Confirmation of the truth above written
At the said William Joubert for and in behalf of my selfe and my wife Joubert
unto fixed my seal and put to my hand this fourteenth day of November
in the first year of the Reigne of their Royall Majesties William and Mary
King and Queen of England France and Ireland &c. Anno 3^o Jovis. Substantia
