

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill to authorize the County Commissioners of Allegany county to subscribe to the capital stock of the Western Maryland Railroad Company, or endorse the bonds thereof;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Internal Improvements.

A bill appropriating a sum of money to pay Richard M. Williams, for professional services; Joseph H. Baugh, Sheriff of Carroll county, for services rendered the State;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill to incorporate the President and Directors of the Monumental City Fire Insurance Company;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill to incorporate the Farmers Mutual Fire Insurance company of Carroll county;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill to repeal sections two and three of an Act passed at January session, 1855, chapter 49, entitled, an Act to amend an Act entitled, an Act to aid and encourage enlistments into the Maryland Regiments, in the service of the United States, passed 1854, chapter 15, and to provide for the prompt payment of the bounties therein specified, and to repeal section four of said Act, and to re-enact the same so as to make the bounties therein specified payable to the widows and heirs of deceased soldiers, and to re-enact and amend the same;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill to regulate the issuing of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors within the limits of the town of Cecilton in Cecil county;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Senator from Cecil.

A bill to incorporate the Plum Point Wharf company;

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mackall, Vickers and Davis, of Washington.

A bill to appropriate a sum of money to pay R. P. Bayly for printing extra copies of the Constitution of Maryland, by order of this General Assembly, at its session of 1865;
