The Chief of the Bureau of Industrial Statistics is appointed by the Governor, with the consent of the Senate, for two years from the first Monday in May; all other officers are appointed by the Chief of Bureau, and hold office during his pleasure. (Chapter 29, 1892).

The *Industrial Bureau* is charged with the collection, classification and arrangement of information concerning the various industries of the State and the needs thereof; and with the annual publication of the data so obtained.

The Chief of the Bureau, under Chapter 101, 1902, appoints two Deputies or Assistants, whose duties are to make inspections of the tenements, dwelling-houses, factories, work-shops and such other places as may be designated, and do such other work as the Chief of the Bureau shall designate.

The Governor appoints, with the consent of the Senate, one President, one State Superintendent and one Commissioner of Immigration, who compose the Bureau of Immigration, for a term of two years from the first Monday in May; the Secretary is appointed by the Board. (Chapter 282, 1898).

The *Bureau of Immigration* is established for the purpose of encouraging immigration to this State. The Bureau is required to prepare and distribute maps, pamphlets and other printed matter pertaining to the resources of the State, the shipping and marketing facilities. The Bureau makes an annual report to the Governor.
