

The bill entitled an act to add a new Section to Article 38, of the Code of Public General Laws, and to repeal certain sections of the Code of Public Local Laws,

Being upon its second reading ;

Mr. Williams proposed the following amendment :

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Add a new section as section 4 ; "Section 4. And be it enacted that the provisions of this Act shall not apply to Baltimore county ;"

Which was adopted.

And the bill as amended was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to exempt the German Baptists of Washington county, from serving on Juries ;

Being upon its second reading,

On motion of Mr. King,

The enacting clause was stricken out.

The bill entitled an Act to revive and continue in force the Act of 1854, chapter 60, entitled an Act to incorporate a society in Washington county, to be styled the "Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington county,"

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading

The bill entitled, an Act to amend an Act, passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, January session, 1866, entitled an Act to incorporate the Maryland Land and Emigration Company ;

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
