On motion of Mr. Jones, (the rules being suspended)

Leave was granted the Committee on Judiciary, to report a bill, to be entitled an Act, to repeal Section six of Article 35, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled Elections, relating to the attendance of judges of election, and section nine of said Article, prescribing the oath of judges of election, and section twelve of said Article, prescribing notice of election to be given by the Sheriff of the several counties, and to enact a substitute for each of said sections.

The bill entitled an Act, to release all claim to and interest
