The bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Frederick Library Association of Frederick city.

The bill entitled, an Act to repeal the Act, passed at January session, 1854; chapter 258, entitled, an Act to incorporate a bank of the name and style of the Farmer's and Merchant's Bank of Greensborough;
