Leave was granted the Somerset and Worcester delegation to report a bill entitled, an Act to authorize the commissioners of Worcester county to establish the road as it now runs, through the lands of Benjamin Elliott, as the line between Worcester and Somerset counties.

Leave was granted the Washington county delegation to introduce a bill to incorporate Oak Spring Lodge, No. 9, Independent Order of Good Templars, Hagerstown, Md.

On motion of Mr. Evans,

Leave was granted the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact sections 7 and 8 of Article 29 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the appointment and compensation of assistant counsel.
