No. 48. An act to incorporate the town of Ellicott's Mills by the name of Ellicott's city.

No. 49. An Act to change the name of Benjamin Edes Long.

No. 50. An act to incorporate the Chestertown Water Company.

No. 51. An act to refund to Issac Amos, late Sheriff of Harford county, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury.

No. 52. An act to refund a sum of money erroneously paid into the State Treasury by William D. Bowie, Jr., in the year 1866, on account of storage of tobacco.

No. 53. An act to incorporate the town of Church Creek, in Dorchester county.

No. 54. An act to repeal an act passed at January session, 1864, chapter 105, entitled, an act to repeal sections 42 and 43 of article 66, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to manumissions, and to enact a substitute therefor, providing for the manumission of slaves, and also to repeal sections 42 and 43 of article 67, of the Code of Public General Laws, title, "negroes," and sub-title, "free negroes and manumission.

No. 55. An act to repeal section 99 of article 30, of the Code of Public General Laws, title, "crimes and punishments," sub-title "larceny," and to re-enact the same with an amendment.
