No. 418. An act to add a new section to article 10 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled attachments.

No. 419. An act authorizing the County Commissioners of Prince George's county, to dispose of the present Almshouse, and to purchase or build another.

No. 420. An act to revive and amend the act of incorporation of the town of New Windsor, in Carroll county, passed at December session, 1843, chapter 47, and to repeal the 14th section thereof, and re-enact the same with the following new and additional sections:

No. 421. An act to amend and re-enact section 92, article 17 of Public Local Laws for Queen Anne's county, relating to Justices of the Peace and Constables.
