- Members:** 8-member board—2 appointed by the governor for 5-year term. *Ex officio* members: professor of psychology in medical school, University of Maryland; 2 sociologists from University of Maryland and Johns Hopkins (to be appointed by president of each university); professor of constitutional law, University of Maryland School of Law; and 2 members of the Maryland Bar (appointed by governor).
- Term:** 5 years for 2 bar members appointed by governor.
- Employees:** Members of board to receive *per diem* salary. One member of board to serve as secretary upon designation by chairman.
- Function:** Gives general consultative and advisory services on problems and matters relating to professional and legal relationships of patients confined in the Patuxent Institution. Also authorizes surgery on defective delinquents.

**Sundry Claims Board**

**Established By:** Md. Code Ann., art. 41, § 188A.

- Head:** Chairman and secretary designated by governor from among members.
- Members:** Attorney general or representative.  
Comptroller or representative.  
Director of budget or representative.
- Term:** No provision.
- Removal:** No provision.
- Employees:** No provision.
- Function:** Administers benefits whenever a prisoner in Patuxent or Maryland Penitentiary, or any institution under supervision of the Board of Correction, sustains a compensatory injury.

**Department of Parole and Probation**

**Established By:** Md. Code Ann., art. 41, § 108.

- Head:** Board of Parole and Probation—chairman is the director of parole and probation.
- Members:** Chairman and two associates appointed by the governor with advice and consent of the Senate.
- Term:** 6 years—staggered.
