Thirdly. Do you, to the best of your apprehension, believe, that the testator was at the time of his so doing, of sound and disposing mind, memory, and understanding?

Fourthly. Have you respectively subscribed your names to this will, at the request, and in the presence of the testator, and have you done the same in the presence of each other?

These questions being answered in the affirmative, they are to take the following oath; which is also to be entered at the foot of the will, viz.
