

cssts and charges he may have been put to by paying for the deed and record, with ten per cent. per annum, that it shall be the duty of said purchaser to re-convey the same to the former owner.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the county commissioners for Allegany county, who reside out of the town of Cumberland, shall be entitled to twelve and a half cents per mile, from the place of their residence, for coming, and twelve and a half cents per mile for returning, once only for each stated or adjourned meeting. Mileage to commissioners of tax.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That all parts of the acts entitled, an act for the more effectual collection of the taxes of Allegany county, and its supplements, that are inconsistent with this act, be and the same are hereby repealed; *Provided*, this act shall not take effect before the first day of September next. Repeal.

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

AN ACT to provide for electing Commissioners for Allegany County, and prescribing their Powers and Duties.—1829, ch. 25.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the persons qualified to vote for delegates to the general assembly of Maryland, in Allegany county, shall, at the time and places of election in said county, that is to say, for holding the election for delegates to the next general assembly, and at the same time in every two years thereafter, vote by ballot for one person, a resident of the first election district; one person, a resident of the second election district; one person, a resident of the third election district; one person, a resident of the fourth election district; one person, a resident of the fifth election district; two persons, residents of the sixth election district; one person, a resident of the seventh election district; one person, a resident of the eighth election district; and one person, a resident of the ninth election district, having the same qualifications as are or shall be required for delegates as aforesaid, to be commissioners for Allegany county; and the judges of elections for each several election [districts] in said county, or a majority of them, shall certify, under their hands, and return, in a form and manner similar to their certificates and return of the election of delegates as aforesaid, the number of votes given in their said respective districts, for a commissioner or commissioners as aforesaid; and the judges of election, from the several election districts in said county, when met at the court house of said county, to ascertain and certify the election of delegates as aforesaid, shall ascertain the number of votes given as aforesaid, for commissioners as aforesaid, in the said election districts respectively, and by a certificate to be filed in the office of the clerk of the county court of said county, and Elections directed—location, returns.
