law, and shall within their respective districts have all the powers which are now vested in the county collector by law, and shall be subject to like liabilities; and the said commissioners of the county, shall be, and they are hereby required to designate the manner in which the taxes to be collected by said collectors respectively, shall be appropriated.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That no person shall be eligible as a collector, except a resident in the collection district, for which he shall be appointed.

A SUPPLEMENT to the ACT,* entitled, an Act for the Re-valuation of Real and Personal Property, in Anne Arundel County, passed at the present session of the General Assembly.—1832, ch. 173.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the commissioners of Anne Arundel county, instead of appointing one or more assessors for each election district, as is provided for in the act of November session, eighteen hundred and twelve, chapter one hundred and ninety-one, shall appoint three suitable and discreet men, whose duty it shall be to go together throughout the county, and value and assess all the real and personal property in said county, agreeably to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, and the said commissioners shall also appoint one assessor for the city of Annapolis.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners shall allow the said assessors such compensation for their services as they shall think just and reasonable, not exceeding the sum of five hundred dollars each.

CONSTABLES.

AN ACT for the Compensation of the Constables of Anne Arundel County.—1835, ch. 129.

Salary of

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That there shall be paid to each of the constables in and for the said county the sum annually of twenty-five dollars, in consideration of the services which they are required to render by the acts of assembly for which no fees of office are now fixed by law, which said sum the commissioners of the said county, are hereby required to assess and levy on the said county, at the time when they shall make the levy for the other expenses of said county; *Provided*, that it shall and may be lawful for the said commissioners or a majority of them to refuse to pay, and to retain for the use of the said county, the said sum in any case in which it shall appear to them that the constable otherwise entitled to receive the same, has been negligent or remiss in the performance of his duties as such.
