school money which the law makes it the duty of the said court to draw for, receive and pay over, may for every such offence, Penalties and at any time within two years after the committing of the same, be indicted therefor, in the county court of said county; and if upon trial he shall be found guilty of misconduct as aforesaid, he shall suffer for each and every offence as aforesaid, a fine of one hundred dollars, to be collected from him by the sheriff of said county who shall forthwith pay over the sum so collected, to the orphans court of said county for the benefit of the school funds of said county; and moreover the person that may be found guilty as aforesaid, shall in addition to the said fine, be compelled by the said county court to forfeit and pay an amount equal to twice the sum of money that the jury Twice the which shall try the matter of said indictment, shall find as the amount of damages. amount of damages sustained by the said school funds, or by any school or teacher, or person or persons, in consequence of the misconduct of the person indicted as aforesaid, which forfeiture shall be collected and paid over by the said sheriff with- To be out delay, one-half thereof to the said orphans court for the collected. benefit of the school fund aforesaid, and the other half thereof to, and for the use of the party or parties injured, or among such parties according to a just apportionment to be made to them respectively by the county court under the finding of the jury as aforesaid.

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That any person, who, whilst Responsibeing or acting as a school commissioner in any district in said bility of S. county, shall abuse the trust reposed in such commissioner by sioners. law, or be in any manner guilty of a violation of his duty as Penalties. such, shall forfeit and pay for each and every offence, the sum &c. of twenty dollars for the benefit of the school funds of said county, which said fine shall be recovered by indictment, in the same manner as mentioned in the preceding section, and be collected and paid over in the like manner, wholly to the orphans court.

SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That all school moneys to be Moneys not distributed in said county, the apportionment whereof, is not specifically specifically, or otherwise particularly, herein before provided for, shall hereafter be apportioned by the said orphans court, among the several election districts in the proportions follow- How apporing, to wit: to Hall's Roads district, twenty-two per cent. tioned. thereof; to Bel-Air district, twenty-two per cent.; to Marshall's district twenty-one per cent. thereof; to Dublin district, twenty-one per cent. thereof; and to Abingdon district, fourteen per cent. thereof; and it shall be the duty of the said orphans court to give early and public notice, by advertisement Notice in a newspaper published at Bel-Air, of every apportionment thereof made by them as aforesaid, and the net amount thereof, and a
