A further and additional SUPPLEMENT to an ACT, entitled, an Act to provide for the relief and support of the Poor and Indigent Persons of Worcester County, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-five.—1839, ch. 218.

*Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of Worcester, be, and they are hereby authorized and required to levy and assess on the property in said county, according to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, such further sum or sums of money as the commissioners aforesaid, or a majority of them, may deem necessary to carry out and complete the purpose of the said original act, not exceeding in the whole the sum of forty dollars. Levy authorized.

A further SUPPLEMENT to the ACT, entitled, an Act to authorize the appointment of Commissioners and the division of Worcester County into School Districts, and for other purposes.—1839, ch. 280.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the proceedings of the board of primary schools of Worcester county, since their appointment, be, and they are hereby declared valid and legal, and the apportionment made by them between the school districts of said county, shall be continued or altered, in their discretion, until the population and limits of said districts be ascertained. Acts of board of primary schools declared valid.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said board shall have power, if they deem it expedient, to appoint a clerk to said board, and to allow him such compensation as they shall consider proper, to be paid out of the school funds of said county. To appoint a clerk.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the members of said board of primary schools, shall be entitled to the same per diem allowance as judges of the orphans court of said county, to be paid out of the school fund aforesaid. Per diem to members of board.
