REPLEVINS.

The law between Tenant and Landlord is indexed in page 2619, word 'Distress.'

In replevins the court shall, upon a motion for return of the property taken, inquire into the circumstances and nature of defendant's obtaining possession, and if it shall appear that such possession was forcibly or fraudulently obtained, or that the possession being first in the plaintiff was got or retained by the defendant, without proper authority and right derived from the plaintiff, the court may refuse to order a return—1785, ch. 80, sec. 14, . . . . . 235

RETAILERS OF SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS.

Retailers may be suppressed by the courts on complaint of keeping a disorderly house, or permitting liquor sold by them, mixed or unmixed, to be drank in or about the house—1784, ch. 7, sec. 9, . . . 184  
 Nothing in this act to prohibit any merchant or shop-keeper to sell any wine, &c. not less than ten gallons, so that it be not drank in the house or shop—1784, ch. 7, sec. 11, . . . . . 184  
 Not to prohibit any person, his agent, &c. to sell or barter any such liquor, not less than one pint at a time, to tradesmen, labourers, or others, hired or employed—1784, ch. 7, sec. 11, . . . . . 184  
 Two of the justices during the recess of the court may, for such reason, suspend such retailers till the meeting of the court, who may determine thereon—1784, ch. 7, sec. 11, . . . . . 184
