## APPENDIX.

## PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.

## TOBACCO.

An Acr supplementary to an Act, entitled, an Act to regulate the Inspection of Tobacco in Prince George's county, passed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter two hundred and forty-five. 1838, ch. 64.

Section 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Mary- Scales. land, That there shall be provided and kept by the inspectors weights, at each of the tobacco warehouses in Prince George's county, provided. proper and sufficient beams, prizes, screws, blocks, tackles, weights and scales; and also a set of small weights, such as are provided for the standing weights of each county, and proper marking-irons, seals, and all other necessary articles which may be required in the opening, uncasing, and inspection of tobacco, and the said inspectors are hereby required constantly to keep the same in good repair, under the penalty of one Kent in hundred dollars, and the charges and expenses thereof shall be order. paid by the said inspectors, out of the money accruing to the thereof. state from their respective warehouses, and they shall be allowed for the same in their respective accounts with the treasurer of the western shore; Provided, true, faithful and proper vouchers for the same, under oath, shall be produced Youchers and exhibited at the time of their settlement with the treasurer required. aforesaid.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That whenever any inspector of When inobacco, at any of such warehouses, shall be sick or disabled, sick, &c. and thereby prevented from attending to his duty, in such case, such inspector shall appoint a person of integrity and A deputy skill in the curing and packing tobacco, and the quality and authorized. condition thereof; and the person so appointed shall view and inspect, pass and mark, or condemn and refuse, as the case may be, all tobacco brought to the said warehouses during the
