

CHAPTER 94.

AN ACT to repeal the eighteenth Section of the first Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany County," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section eighteen of Article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany County," is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows: He, (the Clerk of the County Commissioners,) shall be entitled to such compensation as shall be fixed by the County Commissioners not exceeding six hundred dollars. Repealed and re-enacted.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 95.

AN ACT to repeal the thirty-second Section of the fifth Article of the Public Local Laws, entitled "Calvert County," relating to Justices of the Peace and Constables, and provide for three additional Justices of the Peace for said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the thirty-second Section of the fifth Article of the Public Local Laws, entitled "Calvert County," relating to Justices of the Peace and Constables, be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted as a substitute therefor: Repealed and substituted.

Sec. 32. There shall be the following number of Justices of the Peace and Constables for Calvert County, to wit: for Election District number one, Justices of the Peace.
