

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill for the protection of owners of vessels trading in Maryland waters.

Mr. Latrobe (the rules being suspended,) submitted the following order :

Ordered, That it be entered on the Journal that the Hon. James Pentland, and the Hon. H. Tillard Smith, are absent from this House on public business of the State.

And the House proceeded to the consideration of House bills entitled to a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to pay Elizabeth<sup>deceased</sup> Dorsey, of Frederick county, widow of Vachel W. <sup>Dorsey</sup> ~~Dorsey~~, who was a soldier of the war of 1812 from the State of Maryland, an annual pension of eighty dollars during her natural life,
