Section 1, line 3, after the word "bonds," insert the words, to be redeemed in fifteen years.

Section 2, line 5, after the word "of," strike out the word "five," and insert in its place the word six.

Section 1, line 5, after the word "annum," insert the words, payable semi-annually.
