**COMMITTEE FOR INVESTIGATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS
 RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN
 MARYLAND.**

(Senate Resolution 1—Special Session of 1937.)

Recognizing the lack of uniformity in the laws relating to the licensing and regulation of the manufacture, sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages in this State, this resolution was adopted by the Senate and the Governor was requested thereby to appoint a Committee consisting of five persons, one to represent the State Law Department, one the State Comptroller, and three to represent the public at large, no one interested in any way in the manufacture or sale of alcoholic beverages being eligible for appointment on the committee, to make a careful investigation and study of said laws and regulations, including license fees and taxes, and to report to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before January 15, 1939, with such recommendations as the Committee might deem desirable, with drafts of proposed legislation.
